





ADDRESS OF HIS MOST EMINENCE AT THE 4TH EDITION OF THE BABA ALADURA INTERNATIONAL YOUTH CONFERENCE (BAIYOC), CENTENARY EDITION, HOLDEN ON THURSDAY 4TH SEPTEMBER 2025
AT INDOOR HALL, TESLIM BALOGUN STADIUM SURULERE LAGOS

Your Eminences, the Advisory Board members seated,

Sons & Daughters of saint Moses Orimolade Tunolase present and those watching us online,

I am delighted to welcome you to the 4th series of the Baba Aladura International Youths conference (BAIYOC) 2025, being the Centenary Edition.

I thank God that you are the youths of ESOCS church celebrating the first one hundred years of Cherubim and Seraphim church and I give thanks to the God of our founder, Saint Moses Orimolade Tunolase, by whose mercies you are alive today and have all arrived here safely from your various stations to participate in this year's Youth conference and to also join His Most Eminence to celebrate the first centenary of Cherubim & Seraphim church. My heart is filled with joy to have you all in attendance. After this time, I am certain that you will be able to carry on with our cherished heritage into the next century of the church. Let us therefore give God seven joyful shouts of Halleluyah, Iye and Hosannah, for preserving the life of the church and our youths as we say..... My prayer for you today is that the centenary anniversary shall bring a turnaround in your life endeavors and the Lord shall lead you in safety back home in Jesus name; Amen.

Being a remarkable event in the life of the church, I urge you to use the opportunity to have an interactive session with His Most Eminence on those issues that have agitated your minds before now. It is my desire that the centenary shall afford you a one off meeting to be well informed than acting in ignorance on the doctrines and liturgical practices of the church. The God of our founder shall continue to direct the youths of the church aright in Jesus name, Amen.

I wish to reiterate here that my address for the centenary themed, "The Lord Reigneth",

Psalm 99:1, is from my conviction that so long as the Lord reigns and dwells between the Cherubims, the Cherubim and Seraphim church shall never be extinguished from the face of the earth until the gospel of Christ reaches all the streets of the world. The conviction arose from the prophetic utterance of the founder as a young adult youth that all the world here is Seraph and as we celebrate the first centenary of the church, the prophecy is almost manifested. You may have a different opinion but record has it that before the advent of Cherubim and Seraphim church, hardly was any church in the world drumming, clapping and dancing, except using organs only in their worships. With the advent of the church, the story is different today as the Cherubim & Seraphim church has affected all other churches with their drumming, clapping and dancing worship methodology. Our doctrines and liturgical practices have been copied and doctored by other churches to suite their fancy. The prophecy of all the world being Seraph does not end in wearing white prayer gowns only but in practicing the Seraphic way of worship and conduct.

The legacy we have today is the work of one committed young adult youth who crisscrossed the length and breathe of the Nigerian nation with his evangelistic movement which culminated in establishing the Cherubim and Seraphim Society we are celebrating today. As stated on page 124 of the book, Makers Of The Church In Nigeria, written by Professor J. A Omoyajowo, "Thus, Orimolade pursued his evangelistic campaigns with the vigour of the Apostle Paul and the enthusiasm of the contemporary Prophet William Wade Harris". My dear young adult youths of white garment Churches, here lies the challenge to all of you present here and those watching us online. We are celebrating and honoring the work of one young adult youth 100 years ago, what shall you be remembered for as we walk through the next one hundred years of the church? When the drums shall be rolled out in celebration of the two hundred years of the church, what shall be said of you? Shall you be remembered as a youth who shifted the ancient landmark? While your answer unfolds in your actions and inactions in the years ahead, I wish to charge you that this book of the law, the legacies our fathers left for us, shall not be destroyed in your own time. God in His wisdom warned Joshua to be careful in doing everything in accordance with the entire law which Moses His servant commanded him and never to depart from it for him to be successful and prosperous in his ministry. "This book of the law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall read and meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything in accordance with all that is written in it, for then you will make your way prosperous and then you will be successful", Joshua 1:8. The import of this verse convinced me to make youths one of the focal points of my administration on assumption of office as the Baba Aladura and Prelate of our dear church on 7th September, 2017. This, we shall continue to pursue with vigor until the youths assumed their desired position as leaders of tomorrow of this church. So far several positions have been put on the table for the youths. It is only for the youths to prove themselves.

To the beloved fathers, parents and guardians seated here and those watching online, let me remind us what God said of Abraham, "For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the Lord, to do justice and judgement, that the Lord may bring upon Abraham that which He hath

spoken of him", Genesis 18:19. What shall the Lord say of you as a parent as we journey through next century of the church? I urge you to be careful of what you say to the youths on the way of the Lord, so that posterity will judge you well when you must have completed your assignments on earth. It may interest you to know that the main objective of the Mount Zion Youth Society, which is the parent body of BAYOC is, "Renewing and refreshing of the youths' minds towards achieving the goals of evangelism", using the instrumentality of ESOCS church.

My advice to our teeming youths is that in the face of daunting challenges of youthful exuberance and peer group pressures, they should remain focused and steadfast. Only then shall you leave your footprints on the sands of time, being a youth rooted in the word of God and the basic principles of the ESOCS church. You must be a youth who does not have inheritance in desecrating the exalted office of the Baba Aladura and have pride in insulting the revered Prelate with brazen impunity, as Daniel said, ".... for as much as before God innocency was found in me, and before thee, O king, have I done no hurt; Daniel 6:22. You must be a youth of honest report, full of faith and Holy Ghost as exemplified by Stephen and few others in the Acts of the Apostles 6:5 and not a youth who is more interested in discrediting others including the leadership.

These are my sincere desire for all Cherubim and Seraphim youths as we journey through the next one hundred years of the church and at the end you can confidently say, "I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith. Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge shall give me at that day, and not to me only but unto all them also that love his appearing"; 2Timothy 4:7-8. May the God of our father Saint Moses Orimolade Tunolase continue to direct your footsteps aright in Jesus name; Amen.

On this note, I declare open, the 4th Baba Aladura International Youth Conference, Centenary Edition, in the name of God the father, Son and the Holy Spirit; Amen.



We are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, called to manifest the excellence and dominion of Christ in every sphere of life.

As we celebrate 100 years of God's goodness, the mandate before you is clear:

To rise as ambassadors of Christ in a changing world;

To be champions of holiness in a generation plagued by moral decay;

To become leaders of influence in society, grounded in prayer, integrity, and service;

To uphold the doctrines, traditions, and spiritual legacies of our fathers, while innovatively engaging the world with the light of Christ.

Beloved, as I read through our anchor scripture, I noticed that the Bible began the verse with, "BUT". This implies further explanation, emphases and distinction. It means that God is bringing us into an understanding of uniqueness and difference. And thankfully, the first thing we are called is "a chosen generation". This is how New Living Translation puts it:

But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.

Did you notice how God sees you? He said, "YOU ARE NOT LIKE THAT". Beloved, can you see that among other people, God intentionally choose you? Not just that, but went further to make you a Priest with royal attributes and by His exclusive powers, sanctified you, placing a personal reserved-right over you. No wonder He said, "You are not like that".

The critical question will be, why will God emphasize that you are not like that? It is so that you will show the praises of Him who has called you from darkness to light. God's desire is for men to see God through you. Is for the world to see the goodness of God – that the earnest expectation of all creation is for your manifestation as Royalty.

My beloved children, you are not just Youthful. You are also Useful. God expects a lot from you - "please don't be like them" – the unfaithful, the immoral, the liars, the evil doers or abominable. Your lifestyle must represent royalty; if it is not found in Christ, it must not be found in you.

2025 Baba Aladura Youth Conference provides us with the rear opportunity to ask ourselves, "Who are we in Christ?" and "Who are we without Christ?". God's desire is that we thrive, glory and reign in Him. Let's seize the platform of this Conference to learn, pray, grow and celebrate our royalty in Christ. Your actions, deeds and conversation must be one that gets supply from Jesus Christ, who is our reigning KING.

The theme, "Royalty in Christ", challenges us to embrace our spiritual identity with boldness. Royalty means responsibility. Royalty In Christ

Bro. Lawrence C. Ekeh ESOCS. NHAC

But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy - 1Pet 2:9-10

BACKGROUND

We know that God had a covenant with Israel through Moses and a very important aspect of that covenant is that God will bless them, protect them, give them land and other things but they must be His people; a tribe or people or nation of Priests.

And Moses went up unto God, and the LORD called unto him out of the mountain, saying, Thus shalt thou say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel; Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and how I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself. Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel - Exod 19:3-6

This was a continuation or what we can call a partial fulfillment of God's covenant with Abraham in Genesis 17, where God renewed His covenant with Abraham. According to the above scripture (Exodus 19), the plan of God is to make Israel a kingdom or Nation of Priests. But, somehow, priesthood was limited to Aaron's family line from Levi the Son of Jacob.

WHO IS A PRIEST?

A priest is someone who is duly authorized to minister in sacred things, particularly to offer sacrifices at the altar, and who acts as mediator between men and God. The office of priest in Israel was of supreme importance and of high rank. The high priest stood next to the monarch in influence and dignity; and is part of the royals in some ancient climes. As a matter of fact, the priest was the indispensable source of religious knowledge for the people, and the channel through which spiritual life was communicated. It is this communication of spiritual life that God intended for Israel, so that through her (Israel – God's own people), everyone on earth will experience God's Spirit that gives eternal life; in fulfillment of the Abrahamic covenant.

In Exodus 19, God said Israel shall be a Kingdom of Priests; it denotes a nation with a ruler; and in their case, God was their King until they rejected God in the days of Samuel. So, Israel ought to be a nation ruled by God where everyone is a priest to other nations – giving God's life to those without it and reviving it in those who fall short of it by way of disobedience. Looking carefully at

this, you will see that Jesus fulfilled this mandate as God's appointed King to raise up Sons of God according to God's life, so that in the world to come, there shall be a Kingdom of Priests, ruled by Jesus to God.

Israel's part is to obey God's voice, that is, God's word and by extension Jesus Christ according to John 1:1. Observe that a priest is appointed, just as Jesus is appointed and the believers are appointed into that Christ's Priestly office by grace. It is this appointment that shows God's compassion on Israel, making them His own peculiar treasure, that is, His favourite and chosen beloved.

DAVID, THE SAMPLE OF GOD'S ROYAL

In 2 Samuel 7:9-16, we see God promising to give David a throne that will last forever. David became God's true royal after Israel rejected God and his (David's) works show the true royalty which God expects from man; which is, "a man after God's heart". In history, royals are the apex of every community and live the best life among their people, but God designated a set of rules for Israel's royals, that they must not multiply women, or trade with Egypt (horses) or multiply Gold (Deuteronomy 17:15-19). Instead, their royals had to write out for himself a copy of the Law of Moses and keep with him and read them every day so that they may fear God all their days, just like David, who was after God's heart at all times. So, in the Book of First and Second Kings; and First and Second Chronicles, every King in Israel was compared to David as a standard of God for Royalty in the old covenant.

JESUS, GOD'S CHOSEN, GOD'S APPOINTED KING

We see Jesus as the fulfillment of God's promise to Abraham. It was Jesus that is the blessing of Abraham; that if a man embraces, that man becomes a blessing to others. For Jesus is the true blessing of God to mankind.

Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He saith not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to thy seed, which is Christ - Gal 3:16

It is Jesus that will fulfill the Davidic covenant and sit on the throne of God forever; portraying the standard of divine Royalty. Jesus is the true royal who does not need to write out the Law to obey and read them because He is the Law, the fulfillment of the Law, the Word of God and the Life that gives the Law and God's Word, power. It is He that gives us everlasting grace to become royals, yes, a kingdom of priests to His Father and our Father. No wonder he told the Samaritan woman that what He gives quenches the thirst of man and keeps on quenching every thirst that may arise from man (John 4:13-14); a fountain that springs up into everlasting life. That is, a continual flow of God's grace by way of the Holy Spirit, to ensure that men continually go after God like their ancestor David and write God's Law in their hearts with the very Hand of God to the transformation of that man into God's Royal, who will not go back to Egypt or become unclean (defiled by not just physical women but every form of defilement) or raise up another god for himself in Gold and Silver.

THE DISCIPLES OF JESUS AND PRESENT-DAY BELIEVERS

But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you; and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth - Acts 1:8

This is Jesus' command to His disciples and from the foregoing, it connotes that His disciples will carry on His work and especially His identity as the true Royal Priest that gives Life to all and sundry. Therefore, their witnessing is about the transformation that had occurred in their life

through the Word of Christ and empowered by the Holy Spirit to never go back to Egypt, remain holy and consecrated from defilements and have no other god but Him. Their duty as priests includes being an indispensable source of religious knowledge for the people, and the channel through which spiritual life was/is communicated; that Life of Christ, which holds all power in heaven and on earth to transform lives.

THE MAKING OF DIVINE ROYALS

It is this witnessing; this transformation, this priestly duty and this royal character of Jesus, the very Word of God, that the Apostle, Peter put forward to "the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia," in 1 Peter 1:1. These are gentile believers like you and I, who, like the Apostles and early disciples, are witnesses; are called and are appointed of God to be His royal priesthood; a royalty in Christ Jesus.

To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious, 5 Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ - 1Pet 2:4

It is this Jesus that although by human standard, he was disallowed or rather rejected, but chosen, that is, selected and appointed by the Father to be a living stone. This living stone is the foundation stone and the leading cornerstone that holds every other stone together. He is not just the foundational stone but a living stone; which has life in itself and then communicates this life to His disciples and Apostles, who are the house of God – making them royals like Himself. A house that has spiritual life and belonging to God's priesthood generation. Which offer spiritual sacrifices that are acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. The spiritual sacrifice is only acceptable if they are originated and appointed by God as mentioned earlier. So, they continue being God's representative on earth, a continuation of Jesus, the divinely appointed royal of God, who is the monarch of all creation and who, through the Holy Spirit is making divine Royals.

Peter the Apostle goes ahead to quote Isaiah 28:16, where God speaks of laying a chief foundation stone for His future house or rather, His future city that will effectively strengthen the faith of other stones laid on it. Yes, they see this foundation stone as precious but those without reject Him and will regret such rejection when His Day comes. This precious heart of the believer is wrapped up in their faith in Jesus, the very word of God and their growth nourishment; their Love for Him, which is activated and proven by their obedience to His word and instruction; and their hope of eternal salvation through Him.

But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy - 1Pet 2:9-10

For ye represents:

- a. Who believe in Jesus Christ through faith in Him and by God's manifold grace;
- b. Who rely on the Holy Spirit for living every day, since He ensures our continuous drinking of God's eternal Love;
- c. God's appointed and favourite people due to Christ's death that cleanses us;
- d. Who will not go back to Egypt or develop another god for himself or defile himself;
- e. That Jesus is very precious to and so feed on His Word daily for spiritual nourishing and growth;
- f. The recipients and beneficiaries of Abraham's blessings;
- g. That obey God's word to the latter; and

- h. Who retain God's life in us and communicate it to others as His witnesses and priest. We are clearly chosen and appointed by the Father to our generation to be Royalty on earth as Adam and Eve were, to pursue divine dominion on earth on God's behalf. It is this Royalty in Christ we ought to display in this dark world as lights, because we are empowered by the Holy Spirit to be holy as He is holy. Therefore your royalty in Christ involves:
 - a. Being born again (1 Peter 1:23)
 - b. Live a peculiar life the Christ kind of Love and Life which is clearly different from what the
 - world expects and practices;
 - c. That peculiar Life will show the praises (thanks to God for what He has done called you out of darkness into His light) of God through that same life that is not conformed to the world but transformed by the Holy Spirit who renews your heart to offer acceptable sacrifices to God and do the perfect will of the Father;
 - d. The peculiar life is the practice of that Life of Jesus through the agency of the Spirit who is Holy and works to make you holy; and
 - e. Total obedience to God's word and His Spirit and in total disobedience to your fleshy desires.

Your royalty in Christ requires you to live as God purposed and representing Him by giving life to everything you touch and everywhere you find yourself; like David and Jesus who lived their whole life pleasing God and not themselves. Yes, Royalty in Christ communicates spiritual life to your generation and future generations through daily laboring in God's word, practice of that word and obedience to the word, which includes love according to Jesus' standard. Your Royalty in Christ is that you are transformed and being transformed into Jesus day by day through the Holy Spirit and in praise to the Father as His beloved and appointed representative.

Are you living this royalty in Christ? If not, Jesus calls you to this life freely, if you will truly call out to Him from your heart without any pattern or method but a true heart-cry to Him. But if yes, you are encouraged to keep living God's Life in you and keep obeying His Spirit and keep communicating life to everyone, in every place and to everything around you. Then, we shall all celebrate with Hallelujah Joy in God's coming Kingdom of Priests, as eternal Royals to our God and Father.






